- Be a member in good standing of one of the local Central Pennsylvania Member Organizations of the Central Pennsylvania Engineers Week Council. A list of current Council Member Organizations can be obtained on the Council website at www.cpewc.com
- Not be a Registered Professional Engineer or EIT.
- Be a resident of Pennsylvania.
- Be employed within the state of Pennsylvania.
- Be a citizen of the United States of America.
- Not be an officer of the Council (i.e. Council Chair, Vice Chair, Secretary, or Treasurer are not eligible.)

EVALUATION CRITERIA FOR SELECTION

Nominations must demonstrate achievement and accomplishment of the Nominees in the following areas:

- Academic Achievements
- Occupational Achievements
- Professional and Educational Achievements
- Technical Achievements
- Citizenship

Evaluations will be numerically weighted based on the percentages indicated on the application. The selection of the award recipient is based solely on the information provided on this Nomination Application.
